June 28- August 20, 2021

**Camps Nisqually, Columbia, and Puyallup:** are designed to entertain campers grades (completed) K-5 who enjoy indoor and outdoor games, crafts, learning about nature and themselves. Summer camp is located at Cherrydale Primary School and includes a field trip once a week to a local Park or Hike. Only 30 spots max available a week. Camp runs M-F 7 am to 5 pm.
