ISSUE: x ACTION Authorization to Purchase Classroom Space at Saltar's Point

Elementary

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Current enrollment plus projections require construction of two classroom spaces at Saltar's Point Elementary prior to commencement of the 2013-14 school year. The student capacity of the school is 495 students, the school currently has enrollment in excess of 500 students. This year, to remain below class load lids cited in the Collective Bargaining Agreement with Steilacoom Education Association, a class of students has needed to be placed in the computer lab. The most efficient and timely way to provide needed space is through modular construction.

Design work for classroom space through KCDA is complete, and fabrication needs to begin in order for the additional classroom space to be installed on time. Since the Board was last briefed on the project, the project manager (Kelley Wilson of ESD 112 Construction Services Group) has met with representative staff members and conversation has continued with the principal and the Town of Steilacoom regarding the building design.

The facility is a building that will contain two classrooms, restrooms, and a foyer. The building's design and construction will closely mirror the facility at Saltar's Point Elementary and the classroom spaces being added will be of the same standard all classrooms in the district.

The cost of the building is \$375,228.00, which is in accordance with the budget for the project. Procurement through KCDA is permitted for public school districts who are members of the KCDA cooperative (which the District is). KCDA bids products on behalf of the cooperative as a whole.

The cost for performance bonds is included in the approval amount.

This classroom space will provide needed classroom space for students in grades 4 and 5 to accommodate existing and anticipated enrollment.

RECOMMENDED DECISION:

It is the recommendation of the Superintendent that the Board of Directors authorize purchase of a modular classroom through KCDA in the amount of \$375,228 plus tax.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

Expenditure from the capital projects fund, including use of impact fee resources.
