FlashAlert Messenger App

FlashAlert Messenger app is designed to send push notifications to parents for weather-related school delays or closures.

DOWNLOAD THE APP

You will find the free FlashAlert Messenger app at Google Play and in the iTunes app store.

Download the app and install it on your phone or tablet.

The first time you open the app, it will ask you to link to your existing FlashAlert Messenger account, or to go to the FlashAlert website and create an account and then link.

LINK THE APP

Linking the app to the account allows the app to receive push notifications from the organizations you have subscribed to on the website in the "My FlashAlert" tab.

To see news posted by all FlashAlert's member organizations, there are tabs for regional emergency info, news releases, and high school sports scores.

GET CONNECTED

You must be connected to the internet to receive push notifications or news feeds. That connection can be through cell service or wi-fi connection.

Please note if you get a new phone, you must delete the old app and add the new app (notifications are sent based on the phone's internal ID token, not the phone number).
