



Policy 2012 Instruction

POST ISSUANCE COMPLIANCE POLICY

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This policy is intended to guide Steilacoom Historical School District No. 1, Pierce County, Washington (the "District) in meeting its obligations under applicable statutes, regulations and documentation associated with publicly offered and privately placed securities of the District. This policy addresses obligations of the District that arise and will continue following the issuance of securities. These obligations may arise as a result of federal tax law (with respect to tax-exempt securities) and securities laws (with respect to ongoing disclosure) or as a result of contractual commitments made by the District. This policy outlines obligations that may be applicable to each issue of securities and identifies the party to be responsible for monitoring compliance. In the District, the Executive Director for Finance and Operations will be responsible for ensuring that the policy is followed and checklists and records maintained. The Executive Director for Finance and Operations may delegate responsibility to employees and outside agents for developing records, maintaining records and checklists. The District will provide educational opportunities (opportunities to attend educational programs/seminars on the topic) for the parties identified in this policy with responsibilities for post-issuance compliance in order to facilitate their performance of these obligations.

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A. Transcripts.

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- 1. The District's bond counsel shall provide the District with two copies of a full transcript related to the issuance of securities (for each issue). The transcript shall be delivered in the following form: one bound paper copy and one CD ROM and transcripts shall be delivered to the District within six months following the date of issuance of securities. It is expected that the transcript will include a full record of the proceedings related to the issuance of securities, including proof of filing an 8038-G or 8038-GC, if applicable.
- 2. Bond transcripts will be retained by the following parties and in the following locations within the District: Office of the Executive Director, Finance and Operations.
- B. Federal Tax Law Requirements (Applicable only if the securities are issued as "tax-exempt" securities).

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1. Use of Proceeds.


- a. If the project(s) to be financed with the proceeds of the securities will be funded with multiple sources of funds, the District will adopt an accounting methodology that:
- - ◆ commingles the proceeds and monitors the expenditures on a first in,

first out basis; or

<u>♦ provides for the expenditure of funds received from multiple sources on a proportionate basis.</u>

b. Records of expenditures (timing of expenditure and object code) of the proceeds of securities will be maintained by the Executive Director, Finance and Operations.

c. Records of investments and interest earnings on the proceeds of securities will be maintained by the Executive Director, Finance and Operations. Such records should	
include the amount of each investment, the date each investment is made, the date each	
investment matures and if sold prior to maturity, its sale date, and its interest rate and/or yield. Interest earnings on proceeds will be deposited in the fund in which the proceeds of the securities	
were deposited (if not, then the plan for use of interest earnings will be discussed with the District's bond counsel).	
d. Records of interest earnings on reserve funds maintained for the securities.	
2. Arbitrage Rebate. The Executive Director for Finance and Operations of the District ("Rebate Monitor") will monitor compliance with the arbitrage rebate obligations of the	
District for each issue ("issue") of securities which are described in further detail in the tax	
certificate if any, executed by the District for each issue and included in the transcript for the issue. If the District did not execute a tax certificate in connection with an issue, the Rebate	
Monitor should consult with the District's bond counsel regarding arbitrage rebate requirements.

to facilitate his/her performance of these obligations.	
a. If the Rebate Monitor determines that the total principal amount of tax-

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- 4. Use of the Facilities Financed with Proceeds. In order to maintain tax-exemption of securities issued on a tax-exempt basis, the financed facilities (projects) are required to be used for governmental purposes during the life of the issue. The Executive Director for Finance and Operations of the District will monitor and maintain records regarding any private use of the projects financed with tax-exempt proceeds. The IRS Treasury Regulations prohibit private business use (use by private parties (including nonprofit organizations and the federal government)) of tax-exempt financed facilities beyond permitted de minimus amounts unless cured by a prescribed remedial action. Private use may arise as a result of:
 - Sale of the facilities;
- b. Lease of the facilities (including leases, easements or use arrangements for areas outside the four walls, e.g., hosting of cell phone towers);
- c. Management contracts (in which the District authorizes a third party to operate a facility (e.g., cafeteria);
- d. Preference arrangements (in which the District grants a third party preference of the facilities, e.g., preference parking in a public parking lot).

- (v) Copies of all certificates and returns filed with the IRS (e.g., for payment of arbitrage rebate); and

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(vi) Copies of all leases, user agreements for use of the financed property (agreements that provide for use of the property for periods longer than 30 days), whether or not the use was within the four walls (e.g., use of the roof of the facility for a cell phone tower).	
C. Ongoing Disclosure. Under the provisions of SEC Rule 15c2-12 (the "Rule"), underwriters are required to obtain an agreement for ongoing disclosure in connection with the public offering of securities. Unless the District is exempt from compliance with the Rule as a result of certain permitted exemptions, the transcript for each issue will include an undertaking by the District to comply with the Rule. The Executive Director for Finance and Operations of the District will monitor compliance by the District with its undertakings. These undertakings may include the requirement for an annual filing of operating and financial information and will include a requirement to file notices of listed "material events." D. Other Notice Requirements. In some instances, the proceedings authorizing the issuance of securities will require the District to file information periodically with other parties, e.g., bond insurers, banks, rating agencies. BACKGROUND INFORMATION:
Since 2001, schools that receive discounts on internet access or internal connections through the E-rate program have been required to certify their compliance with the federal law known as the Children's Internet Protection Act (CIPA). In 2008, Congress passed the Protecting Children in the 21 st Century Act which imposed additional requirements under CIPA. This fall the Federal Communication Commission (FCC) issued an order clarifying the requirements for school policies. Currently, to comply with CIPA, school districts must update their internet safety policies by July 1, 2012 to require: • Education of minors regarding safe and appropriate online behavior • Cyberbullying awareness and response
The revised Electronic Resources Policy (2022) satisfies these new requirements. The policy contains new language requiring education of students on the above topics.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:							
Pierce County Skills Center (PCSC) is an InterDistrict cooperative school operated by the Bethel School District for Career and Technical Education (CTE). Participation in the Skills Center is beneficial to SHSD students because students may enroll in the program to gain CTE skills and knowledge that we are unable to offer ourselves due to equipment costs, facility needs, and having a small population of students in our high school.							
Our District's agreement with PCSC expires this summer. For several years, no SHSD students have participated in the program and we have not renewed our agreement like other districts in the cooperative have.							
PCSC has agreed to allow SHSD to participate in a one year agreement for the 2012-13 school year to see whether or not we can generate increased student interest in the programs and so that we may make an informed decision as to whether to consider a longer-term relationship.							
The agreement has standard language regarding provision of special education services, indemnification, and insurance.							
RECOMMEDED DECISION:							
It is the recommendation of the Superintendent that the Board approve the attached 2012-13 Memorandum of Understanding with Pierce County Skills Center.							

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

This one year agreement entails a capital projects fee that is less than other districts have had to pay who have retained enrollment in the program (\$2000 for us vs. \$4000 for other districts) and diminishes the per pupil enrollment cost from \$150/student to \$50/student. The agreement also allows for SHSD and PCSC to each collect up to .8 FTE for enrolled students (This exceeds the 1.0 maximum for resident students and 1.2 FTE maximum for Running Start students.)

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between Steilacoom Historical School District, No. 1 and Pierce County Skills Center

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into in good faith between the Steilacoom Historical School District, No. 1 (SHSD) and Pierce County Skills Center (PCSC), to provide educational services to SHSD students pursuant to the terms and conditions below.

Purpose and Duration

The purpose of this MOU is to allow SHSD students to attend PCSC beginning August 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013.

Administration

PCSC will be the administrator of this MOU and no separate legal or administrative entity is created under the terms of this MOU.

Finance

SHSD will be responsible for the following:

- 1. Non-refundable fee of \$2,000.00 payable on or before August 31, 2012. This fee will serve as the new member entry fee should SHSD choose to become a full member of the PCSC cooperative following the 2012-13 school year. Payment of this fee will allow SHSD member voting rights per the cooperative agreement for the 2012-13 school year only. Continued voting rights are contingent upon SHSD becoming a full member following the 2012-13 school year.
- 2. Pay a fee of \$50 per student for each program attended based on SHSD's average enrollment from the October and February P223 reports.
- 3. Pay a portion of the SPED liaison salary based upon SHSD's percentage of the total number of SPED students (if any) enrolled in PCSC programs as determined by the averaged counts from the October and February P223 reports.

Enrollment/FTE

PCSC agrees to provide SHSD up to 15 student slots. Enrollment beyond 20 slots will be determined on a space-available basis.

For the purpose of this agreement, it is understood that SHSD and the PCSC shall be funded for all classes up to 1.6 full time equivalent at determined by the Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction per the 2012-13 Enrollment Handbook with no more than 1.0 FTE reported by either SHSD or PCSC. For this agreement, PCSC shall be authorized to claim up to .8 FTE for each student and SHSD may claim up to .8 FTE with the exception of students in the Cosmetology program who will be claimed for 1.0 FTE by PCSC. The PCSC or SHSD may

claim an additional .2 FTE for the total of 1.0 FTE after consultation with the other to determine if the .2 FTE remains unclaimed.

SHSD agrees that the PCSC shall count and report the student FTE based on the hours for which each student is enrolled without regard to actual attendance.

SHSD is responsible for providing ancillary services and administering state testing to any of its students enrolled at PCSC.

Student Information

For the purpose of this agreement, SHSD agrees to provide PCSC access to student address information to be used for mailing newsletters, program brochures, and summer school information. SHSD agrees to provide PCSC access to student health plans, 504 plans, IEPs and/or any other information necessary in order to provide a safe educational environment for all students enrolled at PCSC.

Special Education Liability

It is the intent of the parties is that all costs, damages, and fees incurred as a result of any claim brought by a student under state or federal law related to providing an appropriate education to students with disabilities – including but not limited to Chapter 28A.155 RCW, the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 – shall be paid by the district in which the student resides and that the ultimate responsibility for providing an appropriate program is the resident district. If the PCSC provides services as part of a student with disabilities program, the parties agree to the following:

- 1. PCSC will have a representative as part of the decision process to place the student at PCSC.
- 2. SHSD shall provide PCSC access to all IEP and/or 504 documentation for any enrolled students.
- 3. The resident district will be responsible for transportation and any additional costs associated with the student's placement.
- 4. The student will be subject to the rules and regulations of the PCSC; provided, that if state or federal law limits the application or requires an accommodation, the resident district will provide any necessary support required to reserve the safety of students and the integrity of the education environment.
- 5. The resident district will be responsible for defending and hold PCSC, its officials, employees, and agents, harmless from all claims, costs, damages, and fees (including attorney fees) related to the appropriateness of the program or the adequacy of the prescribed services.
- 6. PCSC shall defend and hold harmless the resident district, its officials, employees, and agents, from claims, costs, damages, and fees (including attorney fees), that it did not provide the agreed upon services for which they are responsible or discriminated against a special education student.
- 7. In the event a claim, complaint, or other process or proceeding is brought which may be attributable to one or both parties, the parties shall confer to discuss and endeavor to resolve the responsibility for the defense of the allegations.

Non-Discrimination

The PCSC shall comply with all the federal, state, and local non-discrimination laws, ordinances, regulations and policies, which are otherwise applicable to SHSD. Accordingly, no person shall, on the ground of race, creed, color, religion, national origin, age, sex, marital status, sexual orientation, sexual identity, pregnancy, or the presence of any sensory, mental, or physical disability, be unlawfully excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to illegal discrimination under any activity performed by the PCSC and its agents under this MOU. Harassment on the basis of any of the foregoing conditions is strictly prohibited. The PCSC shall notify the Superintendent or designee immediately of any decision by a local, state or federal agency, court or jury that the PCSC violated a law, regulation or ordinance prohibiting discrimination. In the event of the PCSC's noncompliance or refusal to comply with this nondiscrimination provision, this MOU may be rescinded, cancelled or terminated in whole or part, and the PCSC may be declared ineligible for further MOUs with SHSD.

Indemnification

Each party to this MOU will be responsible for the negligent acts or omissions of its own employees, officers, or agents in performance of this agreement. Neither party will be considered the agent of the other and neither party assumes any responsibility to the other party for the consequences of any act or omission of any person, firm, or corporation not a party to this Agreement.

Insurance

PCSC is covered by Canfield and Associates Risk Management Pool.

PCSC shall at all times during the term of this MOU, at its cost and expense, carry and maintain general public liability insurance, including contractual liability and professional liability and/or malpractice liability coverage when appropriate, against claims for bodily injury, personal injury, death, or property damage occurring or arising out of services provided under this MOU. This insurance shall cover such claims as may be caused by any act, omission, or negligence of the PCSC or its officers, agents, representatives, assigns or servants or damage to or theft of TPS property caused by its students. The limits of liability insurance shall cover such claims as may be caused by any act, omission, or negligence of the PCSC or its officers, agents, representatives, assigns or servants. The limits of liability insurance, which may be increased from time to time as deemed necessary by TPS, with the approval of the PCSC (which shall not be unreasonably withheld), shall not be less than as follows:

Each Occurrence \$1,000,000 Aggregate \$2,000,000

Assignment

No right or duty under this MOU may be assigned by any party without the other party's written consent.

Waiver

Failure by either party to enforce any provision of this MOU or to declare a breach shall not constitute a waiver thereof, nor shall it impair any parties right to demand strict performance of that or any other provision of this MOU any time thereafter.

Severability

If any provision of this MOU or its application is held invalid, the remainder of the MOU or the application of the remainder of the MOU shall not be affected.

Modifications

The MOU represents the entire agreement between the parties. No change, termination or attempted waiver of any of the provisions of the MOU shall be binding on any party unless executed in writing by an authorized representative of each party. The MOU shall not be modified, supplemented or otherwise affected by the course of dealing between the parties.

Termination

This MOU shall be in effect through June 30, 2013.
