VII. NEW BUSINESS

- A. <u>First Reading of Curriculum Adoption</u> Executive Director Weight explained that past curriculum was not Board approved. The week of April 19 26, 2011, all curriculums will be available for public viewing and then brought back to the Board for adoption. Mr. Scott made the motion to move the adoption to a second reading; Ms. Martinez seconded the motion and the motion passed (4/0).
- B. <u>Course Proposal for Steilacoom High School AP Lang/Comp Class</u> Principal McCrimmon explained the additional AP course request. She stated a mandatory parent/student AP class meeting is being instituted this spring to clarify misconceptions and confusion regarding AP classes. Mr. Callanan made a motion to move the course approval to a 2nd reading; Ms. Martinez seconded the motion and the motion passed (4/0).
- C. <u>Technology Replacement</u> Roger Meyer, Technology Dept., presented a five (5) year replacement cycle for District technology. Mr. Scott made a motion to approve the proposal of replacing 180 PC units funded from the 2010-11 school year budget. Ms. Martinez seconded the motion and the motion passed (4/0).
- D. <u>First Reading of Policy 4060, Distribution of Materials</u> Mr. Cohen presented changes to the existing policy to reduce staff workload and move to electronic website inclusion. Board members expressed concerns and suggestions and asked for a sample of what the website area would look like. Mr. Scott made a motion to move the policy to a second reading. Ms. Martinez seconded the motion and the motion passed (4/0).
- E. <u>Network For Excellence in Washington Schools</u> This consortium is the financial group backing the McCleary vs. State lawsuit regarding the State fulfilling its constitutional duty to amply provide for the education of all Washington students. The organization is asking for support through resolution and a monetary donation from the District. Chair Winkler requested that the Superintendent bring a resolution to the next Board meeting recommending that the District commit \$1/student to include only the brick & mortar student population.
- F. <u>Special Board Meeting, April 30, 2011</u> A Special School Board Meeting will be held Saturday, April 30, 2011, in the Professional Development Center (Pioneer MS – Steilacoom). The agenda will most likely include Board policies series 1000, facilities planning, transportation and real estate. No action will be taken at this meeting.

• Larry Wilcox, DuPont City Councilman reported on the DuPont City Council decision to donate \$1000 to the high school reader board project.
