I. CALL TO ORDER

The Regular Meeting of the Board of Directors of the Steilacoom Historical School District #1 was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

- A. Pledge of Allegiance was led by Sam Scott.
- B. Roll Call Sam Scott, Mike Winkler, Jeni Martinez, Kevin Callanan, Don Denning and Bill Fritz, Secretary/Superintendent were present.
- C. <u>Approval of Agenda</u> Mr. Denning moved to approve the agenda; Mr. Callanan seconded the motion and the motion passed (5/0).

III. INTRODUCTION OF NEW STAFF

Each building principal introduced new staff that were in attendance and recognized those not able to attend the meeting. Mr. Winkler and Superintendent Fritz welcomed the new hires to the District and thanked them for their service to students.

The District currently subscribes to the Eduportal Service and adding this feature would reduce the number of paper Board packets and increase efficiency and effectiveness in preparation and presentation of Board meetings, at a minimal cost.
- B. <u>Transcript Report, BERC Group</u>- Dr. Shawn Bachtler reviewed the research and background behind transcript analysis and presented results of Steilacoom High courses in comparison to the Washington Higher Educating Coordinating Board and proposed Core 24 requirements. The analysis made recommendations to the District as to focus areas for future high school courses.

- A. <u>Financial Report</u> Teena Barnes reported on September enrollment actual vs. budget. She reported the various fund balances and reported that a vehicle had been purchased for the maintenance/grounds department. She also announced that Sodexo, food services contractor, has been named #1 in 2010 Diversity Top 50 Companies.

Construction/Maintenance Report Jean Marc LeRoy reported on Cherrydale Primary roof repair; research on portable classroom space at Chloe Clark Elementary; Anderson Island maintenance and capital projects; Pioneer Middle School closeout and capital projects and maintenance items; high school real estate purchase, maintenance, capital projects and the delivery of new furniture. He is also looking into the assessment and cost analysis of Pioneer Middle School Steilacoom.
